2020 EDIDP calls published



The Commission has published the 2020 EDIDP [calls for proposals](#). The deadline for submission is 1 December. Information concerning the organisation of an info day will be communicated at a later stage.

New era for the European Defence Skills Partnership



2020 marked the start of the implementation of the [European defence skills strategy](#), developed within the framework of the European Defence Skills Partnership ([EDSP](#)). ASSETS+, a €5 million project receiving Erasmus+ funding, involving a large number of EDSP members, kicked off in January. It will develop training and related activities in the area of new and emerging technologies to meet the needs of the defence sector.

A comprehensive list of [EU funding](#) for skills suitable for the defence sector became available to

create a one-stop-shop at EU level for relevant funding. It can help interested organisations identify the most suitable programme for addressing their skills needs. It is complemented by a selection of [best practices](#) on funding and activities.

Last but not least, a pilot project on a European defence [VET platform](#) kicked off to deliver a demo version and recommendations for a fully-fledged on-line database helping young talents finding their way into the defence sector.
