TECES's primary mission is to create synergies between different stakeholders (companies, research organisations & universities, government, etc.) and to foster research development and business cooperation between companies and research institutions.

TECES has been a leader and coordinator of various Slovenian strategic partnerships and demonstration pilot projects. It is also one of the key actors in preparing and implementing the Slovenian Smart Specialisation Strategy (S3) 2014 - 2020 and 2021 - 2027.

TECES is a founder and coordinator of three Slovenian partnerships (clusters): TECES - Energy Cluster (since 2007), SRIP Smart Buildings and Home (since 2017) and the Slovenian Energy and Environment Partnership in Defence - **SiEnE** (since 2020).
